First, our God has given wonderful students to CCS. Our students constantly are being used of God to amaze and to inspire us toward excellence. Apart from the rigors of their every day academic and extra-curricular programs, our students have made me very proud to be their Administrator by how they excel in the arts. I have listened to them as they defended their science fair projects and research, viewed their art pieces, observed them during career day, watched as they competed in chess and spelling bees, evaluated their math competition results, enjoyed numerous choral and instrumental performances and appreciated the oratorical skills during “speech meets.” I praise God for our students.

Scholarship Program. The program operates without government assistance, honors academically-able, Black, American, high school students and provides scholarships for a substantial number of outstanding program participants.

Thirdly, I continue to boast in God for allowing our precious school to be accepted as candidates for accreditation with the Association of Christian Schools International and with the Middle States Association. Our acceptance indicates that CCS is on track to receive full accreditation within as little as one year. Because full accreditation exists to verify that a quality educational program is being offered and because I am convinced that CCS offers a quality program, my goal is to reach full status within fifteen months from the date of our acceptance. In spite of the difficulty of the task and the time commitment required for self-study and self-analysis, I give God the glory for the process which will permit CCS to be accredited by a respected national and international Christian association such as ACSI.

Finally, I boast in our God for sending moms and dads who are willing to work in partnership with CCS. Other local administrators have been amazed by the reports of parents assisting us with every area of our school program. I thank God for the respect our parents demonstrate toward me and toward the CCS faculty and staff, as we seek the best learning opportunities for all of our students.
